What EU-CSP III is doing:

- Provides support for the start up of new and expansion of existing micro enterprises for economic and rural development
- Makes technical support available to selected entrepreneurs to enhance their operational capacities for managing sustainable businesses
- Offers an opportunity to communities to improve living conditions by supporting public initiatives for wider community benefit
- Supports non-majority and inter-ethnic business associations to leverage economies of scale for groups of producers
- Supports innovative economically viable businesses

The EU-CSP III programme supports:

- Residents of any of the targeted non-majority communities
- Members of non-majority returnee communities
- Projects with viable and sustainable business plans, according to programme criteria and prior assessment
- Relevant previous experience in the area of proposed business activity
- Willingness to work and develop

Factors considered for EU-CSP III assistance:

- Employment creation
- Expansion of existing businesses
- Addressing needs and priorities in non-majority communities
- Promotion of reintegration of returnees
- Beneficiary's own contribution to the project
